

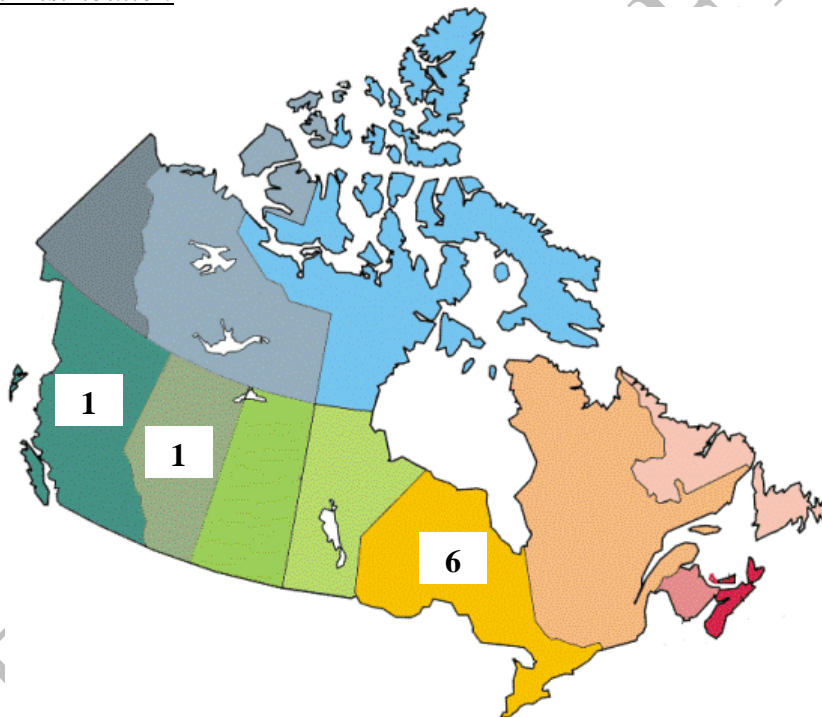
2007 RESEARCH COMPETITION

STATISTICAL INFORMATION

The objectives of the 2007 CPSI Research Competition were to support patient safety research and demonstration projects that:

- Involved interdisciplinary and/or multi-jurisdictional teams of researchers and decision makers. Ideally, direct care providers, patients, personal caregivers, or members of the public would be engaged in the funded projects;
- Demonstrated potential for improvements in patient safety;
- Were readily applied to other healthcare services, settings, or jurisdictions across Canada; and
- Had a strong emphasis on knowledge transfer going beyond publication in peer-reviewed journals and presentations at scientific conferences.

Financial Summary

- Projects eligible for funding requested between \$19,350 to \$120,000 from CPSI. The average amount requested was approximately \$78,725.
- The projects will be co-sponsored by numerous organizations across Canada, with co-sponsors contributing \$1.66M to the 8 projects.
