

2009 RESEARCH COMPETITION

PEER/MERIT REVIEW PANEL

For the 2009 CPSI Research Competition, CPSI received 46 applications, of which 29 were reviewed by an independent Peer/Merit Review Panel composed of national and international patient safety decision makers and researchers.

The Peer/Merit Review Panel met in Ottawa, Ontario on February 16th and 17th, 2010. Using the criteria outline in the call for applications, the Panel rated the applications in terms of the potential benefit to the healthcare system, and scientific feasibility and viability. The 4 projects recommended for funding excelled in both areas.
