



## Canadian Patient Safety Officer Course

### Participant 'Travel Support'

The Canadian Patient Safety Institute (CPSI) acknowledges the significant contribution of healthcare professionals and their commitment to ongoing patient safety initiatives and education. CPSI recognizes and appreciates the financial obligations associated with travel from remote areas to attend professional conferences and continuing education symposiums. As a result, 'Travel Support' has been established with the intent to offset travel expenses to the 2009 Canadian Patient Safety Officer Course in Toronto, if living and working in a remote area in Canada. The amount of each Travel Support is not to exceed \$1500.00. A total of 4 Travel Supports will be awarded for the 2009 Course.

To be eligible, the participant's objective for attending the PSOC must fall into one, or more of the categories below:

- professional development in patient safety
- formal patient safety training
- patient safety research
- dissemination of patient safety principles and programs throughout your organization.

Additional eligibility criteria:

- Each participant is eligible for one Travel Support only.
- The Travel Support must be applied to and used to offset travel expenses only for the 2009 Course.
- Each participant must provide an expected travel budget which is to accompany the completed Registration form.
- It is recommended that each participant provide a list of his/her current or intended organizational patient safety practices and/or initiatives.
- Application for the Travel Support does not guarantee acceptance for the 2009 Canadian Patient Safety Officer Course.
- The Travel Support is non-transferable.
