

## Patient Safety Learning System (PSLS) Reportable Events

A reportable event is defined as a negative treatment outcome or any occurrence that is inconsistent with the routine care of a patient.

**In an attempt to capture events that are related to TOH initiatives, we ask that you please report the following types of events in the PSLS:**

### Corporate reportable events

1. **Adverse drug events** (e.g., bleeding due to anticoagulants, allergic reactions, etc.)
2. **Medication incidents**, such as a missed or incorrect dose
3. **Pressure ulcers (stage 2 or greater)**
4. **Delirium**
5. **Hospital acquired infections** (e.g., UTI, pneumonia, CDI, MRSA)
6. **Any complications related to treatment, tests, procedures or surgery that place patients at risk for injury** (e.g., bowel perforation following scope, wound infection, inadvertent radiation exposure, etc.)
7. **Any other complications** (e.g., deep vein thrombosis, pulmonary embolism, etc.)
8. **Delays in treatment** (e.g., missed positive blood/urine/wound culture)
9. **Falls**
10. **Defective equipment or supplies**
